Alicia Zorzoli, a member of the faculty and executive board of the <u>Christian</u> <u>Latina Leadership Institute</u> housed at Baptist University of the Américas in San Antonio, called her listeners to consider how they are builders in a similar way to the many people who worked together to build the wall around Jerusalem. She also applied principles from the story in Nehemiah to the current call to the church to rebuild broken people.
