David Draper: Today is the Day (Hebrews 4:6-16)

David Draper, pastor of [First Baptist Church](#) in Roscoe, pointed to the message of Hebrews for the early Christian church during its second generation after Jesus' resurrection and ascension. The letter to the Hebrews provides encouragement to those who may have been weakening in their faith.

Life is full of choices, Draper contended. Hebrews 4:6-16 points to three key choices. We must choose between obedience and disobedience to God. We must also choose God's powerful, active and living word, and be transformed by it on a regular basis. Likewise, we must choose Jesus, our Great High Priest, who knows our situation and offers us grace and salvation.
