Jody Hickman: The Joy of Your Salvation (Psalm 51)

Jody Hickman, pastor of <u>First Baptist Church in Rosebud</u>, compares the world to a person who seeks God. The world sees problems as someone else's responsibility to fix. The person who seeks God sees the problem in themselves, acknowledges their sinfulness and repents.

David provides an example in Psalm 51 of one who acknowledges his sin and seeks God's cleansing. He asks God to teach him how to be in right relationship with God. This, in turn, is expressed through seeking to be in right relationship with others.
