Michael Holster: Don't Be a Loser (Galatians 5:1-12)

Michael Holster, pastor of <u>Second Baptist Church</u> in Levelland, opened with examples of moments when people felt like losers. He exhorted his hearers not to be losers, but to be winners in Jesus—which is not to be understood as a "name it and claim it" prosperity gospel. Paul's instructions to the church in Galatia provide the right guidance.

Slavery to sin is a losing proposition. Those who find freedom in Christ will be winners; they must stand firm in the freedom of Christ. Likewise, to win, people must listen to and live in the truth; they must not listen to false teachers, who say a person loses everything who trusts only in Jesus.

Without Jesus, a person is a loser, Holster contended. With Jesus, a person is free.
