

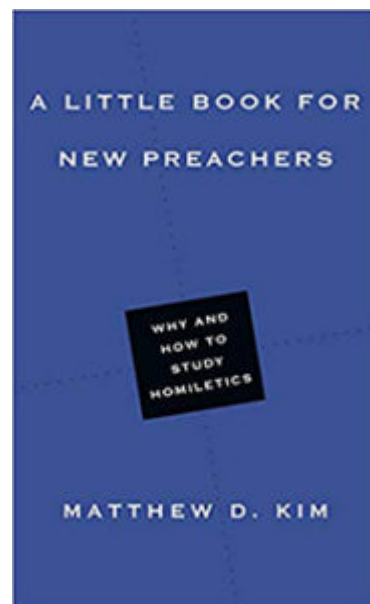
Review: A Little Book for New Preachers
