The three living deans of Hardin-Simmons University's <u>Logsdon School of Theology and Seminary</u> shared their memories of the seminary at a celebratory dinner culminating "Celebrating Logsdon: 20 Years of Seminary Programs," a two-day event marking two decades of service.
