The mobile unit will bring medical care directly to communities that have some of the highest rates of poverty and lack of insurance. It is outfitted with an exam room, monitoring technology such as a non-fetal stress test monitor and ultrasound, and other medical tools needed to fulfill its mission of delivering prenatal and postpartum care to

women living in the colonias. It also is equipped with neonatal capabilities should a hospital need to evacuate during an emergency, such as a hurricane. The vehicle also can serve as a resource for firefighters and other first responders, equipped with liquid cooling vests, wireless vital signs monitors, oxygen units and other tools to assist responders during an emergency.
