## Texas Tidbits: Baylor track stadium approved

Baylor regents approve track stadium. Baylor University's board of regents approved construction of phase one of an on-campus track and field stadium. The \$13.6 million track and field stadium will be built along the Brazos River on the east side of the 93-acre Baylor Stadium property. The facility will accommodate 5,000 spectators and include a 6,000-square-foot team building containing men's and women's team locker rooms, training room, meeting room and equipment space, and a 13,500-square-foot indoor practice facility. Baylor's track and field program has produced nine Olympic gold medals, 36 NCAA championships and more than 600 All-America performances.
