

Texas Tidbits: Wayland designated an All-Steinway School

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[Wayland Baptist University](#) joined the ranks of 170 institutions around the world designated an All-Steinway School by Steinway & Sons. Receiving the certification marked the completion of a nearly \$630,000 initiative led by Wayland's School of Music. Wayland purchased 29 new pianos designed by Steinway & Sons for faculty studios, practice rooms and performance venues throughout the campus. The pianos include Steinway, Boston and Essex models. By completing the initiative, Wayland became the first Baptist university in Texas to earn the All-Steinway School distinction.

He is a graduate of Texas State University, where he earned his undergraduate and master's degrees. In 2000, he received his doctorate in education from Baylor in administration. He is licensed as a certified public

accountant.
